This bill makes voting less accessible to Oregonians who otherwise are unable to reach polling booths due to work, medical or travel constraints, which hinders the democratic process. There is no real evidence that mail in voting has more than the base level of fraud risk that in-person polling has. Voters are also subject to harassment at in-person polling stations that would ultimately generate a higher cost in security detail.
