HB 3197 would be Oregon's first ever procery and restaurant sales tax increasing	

HB 3197 would be Oregon's first ever grocery and restaurant sales tax, increasing prices on legal-age drinkers in Oregon by 8%.

HB 3179 states that additional revenue is needed for youth prevention, yet youth drinking is at an all-time low, a trend that's occurred for more than two decades as existing prevention programs are working.

In 2024, Oregon brewers, winemakers and cidermakers worked with Rep. Sanchez on a taskforce to examine alcohol taxes. The taskforce declined to recommend a tax increase and 87.5% of the public comments submitted opposed tax increases. This does not include hard liquor
