Measure, Appointment or Topic: SB1187

This bill violates federal law - the Federal Energy Policy Conservation Act of 1975 - by using a backdoor method to make natural gas unaffordable. Additionally it is the job of the U.S EPA to set the social cost of greenhouse gas emissions, not a state agency dominated by special interest groups specifically looking to redistribute wealth based on a far removed consensus of global government paid scientists - paid to say that greenhouse gas emissions are responsible for warming temperatures; and even with this group of so-called experts, they report low confidence in the link between greenhouse gases and specific weather related events.
