Dear Members of the Judiciary Committee,

I strongly oppose HB 3884, which directs the Oregon State Police to study firearm hold agreements. While presented as a simple study, this bill paves the way for restrictive gun control measures that could undermine the rights of law-abiding citizens.

Gun owners should not be coerced into relinquishing their firearms under the pretense of "safety." This proposal does nothing to tackle crime or address the root causes of gun violence. Instead, it sets a troubling precedent for further restrictions on responsible firearm owners.

Oregon already enforces some of the strictest gun laws in the nation. Additional government overreach is unnecessary. I urge you to oppose HB 3884 and uphold the Second Amendment.
