This treaty guarantees that the COFA people living among us are entitled to the same Safety Net benefits as US citizens and legal immigrants. I believe that SB 442 is necessary for us to deliver on our commitment as without the COFA shared Office many will continue to rely on emergency rooms as they struggle to understand how to get timely medical treatment and the other benefits, such as housing, TANIF, and SNAP that is now available to them.

I therefore ask for your support on SB 442.
