Suicide makes up the largest share of deaths by firearm in our State, more so than many other States. I always found it ironic that gun control advocates seem to ignore that fact, instead choosing to focus on restricting law-abiding gun owners rather than actually helping reduce the real harm that firearms can cause when they fall in the wrong hands at the wrong time.
