Measure, Appointment or Topic: SB429

SB429 proposes waiting periods to reduce impulse suicide, claiming 77% of suicides are by firearm. Data shows it's closer to 50% in Oregon. Waiting periods delay self-defense, especially for women facing domestic violence, leaving them defenseless against determined individuals. This bill, threatens our constitutional rights and is unlikely to achieve its intended goals of reducing crime or suicide rates.
