There seems to be a misconception among many people who oppose SB 1187 that it will impose new taxes on Oregonians. In fact, this bill will provide **TAX RELIEF** to the citizens of Oregon.

To be clear, the largest fossil fuel suppliers (coal, petroleum products and natural gas) will be required to contribute to a Fund, based on their share of greenhouse gas emissions from 1995-2024.

These funds will be used to help Oregonians pay for such things as wildfire-fighting costs, flood and fire protection for communities, power grid upgrades, agriculture and fisheries, and forest rehabilitation. Currently, Oregonian taxpayers cover the entire cost of these needs. What taxpayer would not welcome some tax relief, particularly for problems they are not responsible for creating?
