Please vote yes on this bill and restore trust in our voting systems which have become clouded in secrecy and restricting in citizen engagement beyond casting the ballot. Providing live feed access to all drop boxes and counting facilities while ballots are being counted will ensure that drop boxes aren't being stuffed with illegal ballots as a result of ballot harvesting, and that counting locations don't have election workers resorting to shenanigans like double counting ballots/batches, throwing out less preferred party votes, or scrupulously critiquing signatures of less preferred party ballots/votes. Providing live feed of ballot boxes and ballot counting rooms will ensure that there is no insidious and fraudulent activity taking place in the future like which did in past elections where nationally election workers were discovered to have double counted ballots, thrown out ballots and batches, and it was discovered that the same people were showing up to ballot drop boxes in the dark of night at multiple locations dropping off large quantities of ballots, when such ballot harvesting was illegal in those states. Shenanigans and fraudulent activity like this is what led to 108% voter turnout in the 2020 election resulting from 13 million more votes being counted than there were registered voters. Votes in which that did not show up during the 2024 election and turnout was under 100%. It is statistically impossible to go over 100% turnout without fraudulent activity taking place. Don't forget that the lawsuits that were thrown out after the 2020 election were not dropped by judges citing a lack of merits or credibility, but that by procedural rules they were not filed in the right time frame and had to be filed before the election. Those lawsuits were filed prematurely in 2024 as the judges had advised in 2020 and we had a much cleaner election and much different results because of it. Let's put these sensitive places under live feed and restore trust in our elections. Thank you.
