Position on Bills at 2025 Session of Oregon Legislature:

HB 3484: Oppose



The Consolidated Oregon Indivisible Network (COIN) is a coalition of over 50 local Indivisible groups throughout Oregon that cooperate and amplify their joint efforts to advance important federal and state legislation and engage with elected officials to promote causes for the benefit of all Oregonians.

COIN opposes HB 3484, which started as a study bill. The -2 amendment was filed after close of business on April 4, which means that the notice to the public of the content of the amendment was zero business hours prior to the 8:00 am public hearing and work session this morning.

We believe amendments should be considered only after sufficient public notice. Zero business hours does not qualify.

On the substance of the -2 amendment, we oppose using additional taxpayer money to process water rights applications.
