Chair Sollman, Vice-Chair Brock Smith, Members of the Senate Committee on Energy and Environment:

Thank you for considering this critical legislation today. SB 1187 is long overdue. Please pass it and Make Polluters Pay. Not only has the fossil fuel industry earned incredible – unfathomable for most of us – profits for decades while quietly poisoning the planet, these companies have known about the damage they were causing since the 1950s, and they have tried to cover it up, with tactics ranging from counterfeit science, to harassment of scientists, to outright lies.

With just a tiny fraction of their hundreds of billions of dollars in annual profits, fossil fuel companies have, for decades, engaged in a deliberate, concerted, and frankly, sinister campaign of disinformation.
