So to compensate for the aging process on our bodies and because I can no longer take a blow like I did in my 20's in the Navy performing Shore Patrol, I have come to rely on legally obtained weapons for our self defense. The Idea that you can sit down in Salem and come up with this communist policy and force eminent domain on rural Oregon and have peole accept someone they do not know to come on our property unannounced and not be met with resistance is ludicrous and a fantasy.
