Today we have expanded to operate the largest bike parking lot in North America. We park an average of 300 bikes a day year-round and up to 450 during the summer. We do this all in the space you could park 20 cars. This investment in the Salmonberry trail will continue to leverage Oregon's existing investments in biking by creating a world class biking destination.

The Salmonberry Trail will bring a range of benefits to Oregonians—boosting local economies through increased tourism, promoting public health through active recreation, and improving transportation safety for those who currently lack safe alternatives to busy highways. It also creates equitable access to the outdoors, especially for rural communities that have historically seen less investment in recreational infrastructure.
