REMOVE Section 17 and Section 19 from the -1 version of the bill.

Section 17 effectively freezes development in areas with limited public infrastructure where ever Groundwater Quality Management Areas are designated. It goes further to give the Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) carte blanche authority to create rules dictating where counties MUST prohibit new structures.

Section 19 permits the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to enter onto private property in GWMAs without landowner consent to inspect subsurface sewage disposal systems — an invasive overreach with almost no checks and balances.
