Young Roots Oregon is a community-based organization that specifically supports Oregonians in Linn and Benton Counties who are pregnant or parenting ages teen to 24 years old and their children. Our mission is to creatively empower young families to build healthy foundations.

Our organization has experienced outrageously long wait times for funding dispersement, inadequate funding for indirect and fringe benefit costs within state contracts, rigid accounting of supplies and materials (i.e. counting the number of papers printed for a specific program to be able to invoice for costs), and non profit salaries not meeting the same equitable pay scale and benefits packages compared to state or for profit employer competition.

Senate Bill 602, if enacted, improves and streamlines how government grants and contracts are structured and administered.
