Dear Members of the Oregon Legislature,

I am writing to express my firm opposition to the proposed bill referenced above. While the language of the bill may appear neutral or well-intentioned on the surface, it raises serious concerns that cannot and should not be ignored - chief among them, its potential to serve as a backdoor for further tightening gun control measures in Oregon.

Do not use veiled language or complex legalese to quietly chip away at the rights of law-abiding citizens.
