As a board member of a very small nonprofit in Portland, 350PDX, I join with many others to ask you to support the <u>recommendations of the state Task Force on Modernizing Grant Funding and Contracting</u> by passing Senate Bill 602. The recommendations are designed to improve the process and outcomes of government grants and contracts by empowering nonprofits to deliver critical services efficiently and cost effectively to Oregonians.

Senate Bill 602, if enacted, improves and streamlines how government grants and contracts are structured and administered. The Bill would make important changes such as create an office of nonprofit partnership and establish a nonprofit advisory council to oversee service improvements, implementation, and compliance.
