I OPPOSE [HB 2567 A and -1].

From the TEXT of [HB 2567 A and -1], " ... SECTION 1....(a) Award grants using available funds in the Heat Pump Deployment Fund established under ORS 469B.466."

\*\*\*There is 'No' budget allocation and or funding source(s) listed in [HB 2567 A and -1].

"...(c) "Disadvantaged community" means a community that has a socioeconomic burden and an environmental, climate or other burden."

\*\*\* [HB 2567 A and -1] does not treat everyone equally under the law. There are Constitutional issues to be addressed and remedied.

\*\*\* [HB 2567 A and -1] codifies and incorporates "Systemic Racism" into Oregon Law.

"... SECTION 1... (2) The Heat Pump Deployment Program is established within the State Department of Energy. The purpose of the program is to award grants to one eligible entity for each region and federally recognized Indian tribe in Oregon to provide financial assistance, including loans, grants, rebates or incentives, for the purchase and installation of heat pumps and related upgrades to individuals who reside within that region or who are members of that tribe."

\*\*\* [HB 2567 A and -1] appears to use Oregonian taxpayer monies to support, "The Heat Pump Deployment Program" on Tribal Lands. Tribal Lands are "sovereign territory."

\*\*\* How can Oregonian taxpayer monies be used to support, "The Heat Pump Deployment Program" on Tribal Lands? Should not revenues generated by Tribal Casinos be used for "The Heat Pump Deployment Program" on Tribal Lands?

"...Section 1... The State Department of Energy...." has 'No' budget allocation and or identified funding source(s) to expand the Department's ability to manage [HB 2567 A and -1].

[HB 2567 A and -1] is fundamentally flawed with multiple discriminatory actions and the lack of additional budget allocation and identified funding source(s) for The State

Department of Energy to carry out "The Heat Pump Deployment Program."

[HB 2567 A and -1] is incompetently constructed and therefore should be rejected and denied.
