But if the county is not going to do their job, I WILL. And it would be far, far better if the COUNTY puts the animals down rather than ME dragging a dead dog to it's owner and demand recompense.

In the meantime, if I catch the dog doing this to my fowl or my neighbor's animals, I WILL DO MY DUTY to protect their ranch and our wee chicken farm. This should be in the definition of the destruction of a dog by the owner as a right, and a right to recompense for the lifetime of animals killed.
