Chair Taylor and Members of the Committee:

The Oregon Vehicle Dealer Association (OVDA) represents all businesses required to possess an Oregon vehicle dealer certification. Oregon RV Dealers Association (ORVDA) represents franchised RV dealers in Oregon. Northwest Auto Trades Association (NATA) represents mechanical and collision repair shops, parts stores, and dismantlers. OVDA, ORVDA, and NATA are neutral on House Bill 3178-A.
