I OPPOSE [HB 3724] as written. Funding for the program is absent and is the reason for my Opposition.

I oppose the sale of marijuana and cannabinoids. This business is causing more harm to Oregonians than the Tax money it produces.

From the TEXT of [HB 3724], "...Is likely to cause minors to unlawfully possess or consume cannabinoid concentrates, cannabinoid extracts, cannabinoid edibles or other cannabinoid products, in order to prevent the unlawful possession or consumption of cannabinoid products by minors...

...Section 2... (e) In order to prevent the unlawful possession or consumption of marijuana items by minors, shall describe, using objective criteria, packaging that is likely to cause minors to unlawfully possess or consume marijuana items. The objective criteria must include, but is not limited to, prohibiting packaging that uses imagery or characters primarily associated with minors when such associations are likely to result in minors unlawfully possessing or consuming marijuana items."

[HB 3724] mandates The Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission to assume more responsibilities but there is 'No' budget allocation(s) and or funding source(s) identified to perform the required enforcement and record keeping.

[HB 3724] is poorly constructed and therefore must be rejected and denied.
