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Local journalism also relies on the digital platforms for news and their writing of local news articles. It is a two-way street, and so taxing the likes of Google, Meta, Bing etc ignores that local journalism also should pay for its use of these free on-line search platforms. Furthermore, government should not be in the role of underwriting journalism, as the core foundation of journalism is the separation of a critical press and government. By the government paying local journalism it will most probably end up pressuring local journalism to print stories most favorable to the current government powers/leaders and their policies, rather providing an accurate and balanced critique for the public at large.
