As a patient of Providence Portland, I am writing to oppose the attempt to spin off its nonprofit home health, hospice and community palliative care programs into a joint for-profit enterprise run by private-equity-owned Compassus. Right now, this Providence/Compassus joint venture is being reviewed by Oregon's Health Care Market Oversight program.
