Dear Chair Nathanson, Vice-Chairs Reschke and Walters,

I am a lifelong Oregonian who values our forests and rural communities.

I urge you to support HB 3489, which will reinstate the timber severance tax in Oregon and support wildfire protection and prevention. Many rural communities and counties today still rely on timber tax revenue, unfortunately.

Currently, the largest timber companies in Oregon are paying a fraction of the cost to protect their private land from wildfires, despite making hundreds of millions in profit. Oregonians and small woodland owners are picking up the majority of the tab.

Oregon is experiencing more frequent and devastating wildfires that are costing taxpayers millions. In 2024 alone, fighting wildfires in Oregon cost approximately \$350 million. By supporting HB 3489, big timber companies will pay their fair share for forest protection, and fund state programs that help prevent wildfires. (One third of the revenue will be reserved for unrestricted use for counties where timber is harvested.)

Reinstating the timber severance tax is a fair solution for all Oregonians. I urge you to support HB 3489.
