I'm asking the legislature to support:

- \$12M to farm to school in the ODE budget
- \$1M to farm to school in the ODA budget
- Fully funding HB3435, School Meals for All

This funding is especially important with the elimination of federal funding sources. Every kid deserves access to nutritious food while they are at school, no matter where they come from or what their families financial situation is.
