My grandparents purchased our farm in 1950 which has a creek running through it. Our farm business was founded in 1940. We have grown decorative cut foliage which is grown along the creek banks and includes our irrigation reservoirs. We also have stream water rights. If this law passes it would adversely affect access to irrigation our plants that we need to access to harvest. Because we grow our own plants along the creek, reservoir, and ponds these water temperatures remain cool from the natural shade from my plants.
