With over 35 years in service to seniors, children and adults with disabilities, I can understand why this bill as written seems to be a positive thing. But in those 35 years I have watched the bureaucracy and administrative burden increase, rather then shore up the existing rules and organizations charged with addressing the issues outlined in this bill. Section 4 outlines the duties of this proposed board and literally every item listed is already the responsibility of an existing state agency, or is addressed in Administrative Rule and Statutes.

The proposed analysis and reporting around labor and workforce issues is already the purview of Workforce Investment Boards who, at the local level, can address areas of concern. WIOA assures this. The needs and issues of this workforce vary significantly around the state and another board, at a macro level, that has no substantive power to make changes, will result in another level of oversite. This bill will take effort AWAY from positive solutions that are in the works.
