The proposed tax is misplaced and incongruent when compared to existing funding sources such as property tax, income tax, the kicker, ending fund balance and retaliatory tax which can all be justified as mechanisms for funding wildfire prevention. Oregon brewers already face massive challenges; inflation, supply chain issues, employee shortages and fewer people enjoying our hand crafted beverages.
