Therefore, I support the provisions of SB 1098, which

Prohibit the exclusion of certain school library books based on the topic or author of the book, prohibits discrimination when selecting or retaining school library materials, textbooks or instructional materials or when developing and implementing a curriculum. It also

directs the Department of Education to provide technical assistance for school library programs relating to book challenges. It

requires challenges to be reviewed only if submitted by parents, guardians, and staff from within the school district. And, finally, it

prohibits removal of materials until review process is finalized.
