As a 74 year old resident of Oregon, I support HB 3187 A-Eng. to protect older Oregon workers. Oregon's current age discrimination law is failing to protect older workers. HB 3187 A-Eng. would address this barrier by prohibiting applicants from disclosing their age, date of birth or graduation date until after an initial interview.
