The main cause of the decreased fish runs in the Lower Deschutes River is the terrible water quality in the Crooked River. Efforts to restore riparian areas along the upper Crooked River have been hampered by ODFW and other state agencies. This legislation may help show these agencies the critical importance of beavers to restore the streams for beavers, fish and endangered mussels as well clean, cool water.
