Dear Chair and Members of the Committee,

My name is Dr. Jessica McConahay, PT, DPT, Therapeutic Pain Specialist, and Fellow of Pain Science. I am a practicing physical therapist at Whole Body Health Physical Therapy in Portland, Oregon. I write to express my strong support for HB 3824A, the Physical Therapy Modernization Act.

As a clinician who spends significant one-on-one time with patients, I witness firsthand the barriers that current outdated referral requirements impose on timely and effective care. Our healthcare system is burdened with delays—patients wait weeks or even months to access care, often enduring unnecessary pain or worsening function. In contrast, physical therapists are uniquely positioned to evaluate and treat musculoskeletal and neuromuscular conditions early, often preventing the need for more costly or invasive interventions.

Physical therapists like myself build trusting, sustained relationships with patients. We spend more time per visit than many other providers, which allows us to understand the whole picture of a patient's health. Yet, under current regulations, we are still subject to referral constraints that do not reflect our doctoral-level education or the modern scope of our practice.

HB 3824A represents a long-overdue update that aligns Oregon law with the evidence-based standards already adopted in many other states. It ensures patients can access qualified, comprehensive care without unnecessary gatekeeping while preserving safety and collaboration within the broader healthcare system.

I urge you to vote yes on HB 3824A to support the kind of healthcare Oregonians deserve—timely, personalized, and effective.
