

We, the undersigned community organizations, businesses, non-profit groups, and public agencies, respectfully request your support for Consejo Hispano's funding request of \$1.5 million to purchase Casa Mariposa in Astoria, Oregon. Casa Mariposa will serve as a vital community hub for all residents in the region, providing a wide range of services centering youth and families.

Oregon's North Coast is home to a growing Latinx population that faces significant barriers to accessing essential services, including educational support, health and wellness programs, workforce development, and tax preparation services. Situated in the heart of Astoria, Casa Mariposa will bridge these gaps and offer a safe, welcoming space where community members can access the resources they need.

Under the dedicated leadership of Consejo Hispano, a capital campaign has been launched that will bring together private and foundational support to purchase Casa Mariposa. To ensure the success of this one-of-a-kind project, it is crucial that the state play a role by contributing \$1.5 million towards the cost of this \$3 million project.

Casa Mariposa supports the needs of the community in the following key areas:

### Educational Support and Youth Empowerment:

These programs will empower individuals to achieve their educational and career goals, fostering long-term community development. ## Cultural and Community Activities:

Casa Mariposa will host cultural events and community gatherings, celebrating our rich traditions and heritage. These activities will strengthen community bonds and provide opportunities for cultural exchange and understanding.

The state's contribution of \$1.5 million is essential to making this vision a reality. Our community yearns for a place that we can call our own. Casa Mariposa will serve as a safe space for children and youth to learn and grow in an environment with no glass ceilings and no roadblocks to top quality educational enrichment and programs.
