RE: Support for HB 2649

Dear Chair Frederic, Vice Chair Weber and Members of the Senate Education Committee,

On behalf of Eastern Oregon University, I am writing to express our strong support for House Bill 2649, which authorizes the governing boards of certain public universities—including EOU—to establish a tuition rate for qualifying students participating in programs developed to cooperate in higher education and economic development with countries located in East Asia.

This legislation is a strategic step toward enhancing Oregon's global engagement and fostering economic development. By allowing institutions like EOU to set tuition rates equivalent to the average in-state tuition for qualifying students from East Asia, HB 2649 positions our university to attract a diverse student body, enrich the educational experience for all students, and strengthen international partnerships.

The bill permits the establishment of separate fees for services used by these students and outlines requirements for student qualification, ensuring that the program is accessible and sustainable.
