## **RE: Support for SB 684 A**

Thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony in support of SB 684 A on behalf of Multifamily NW.

Our top priority is to collaborate with public sector leaders to identify and implement proven solutions to Oregon's ongoing housing crisis.

SB 684 A aligns with our broader goals of addressing Oregon's housing crisis and providing equitable opportunities for all.

The ability to access low-interest, short-term loans for mixed-income developments will provide housing providers with the necessary resources to build projects that benefit both low- and moderate-income residents, while also helping to alleviate the overall housing shortage.
