I am concerned that the provisions for providing reasons for using an unmanned aircraft have been eliminated. In particular, in sections ORS 837.320 1b and 1g where law enforcement is given the freedom to use unmanned aircraft without judicial authority, there should be some corresponding responsibility to provide evidence/reasoning/rationale, at least after the fact, for such use. Something similar to what is currently in ORS 837.335 2b ((b) Not more than 48 hours after the emergency operation begins, an official of the law enforcement agency files a sworn statement with the circuit court that describes the nature of the emergency and the need for use of an unmanned aircraft system.)
