Diane,

Thank you for sending the form for my review. The signature on the form is mine, however the form was misrepresented to me and I was not aware that this was a union membership application.

Six months ago, a man came to my door and said he was doing a survey (my employer) in order to improve services to their clients. He asked me questions regarding services made available to my niece, who is my client. When he finished the "survey" he asked me to sign a form to show I took the survey. He handed me a clip board with the form you emailed me. The top of the form which describes it as a union membership application was covered up by the top clasp of the clipboard. What I did see was the portion of the form which listed my employer, [REDACTED]. This led me to believe it was a legitimate survey. He asked me to sign the top box which I did, then he asked me to sign the bottom. When I read the union information in the bottom box I questioned it and said I didn't want to join a union. He said as long as I didn't sign the bottom portion I would not be enrolled in the union. I did not discover until this morning that I had in fact been enrolled. I opened my paycheck stub to get my employee number and discovered deductions have been made from my payroll for union membership dues.

I believe my membership enrollment was fraudulent, as this person misrepresented who he was from and mislead me as to the implications of my signature. My signature was not for purposes of a survey and at no time did I knowingly authorize deductions to be taken from my payroll for a union membership. I request that all money deducted from my payroll be reimbursed and I also want this membership cancelled.
