As the acting City Engineer of Record, we can confirm extra work and schedule creep was incurred by unmarked utilities, understood to have occurred both prior to the design survey of which the design was based, in addition to those that were not marked in accordance with the Oregon Administrative Rules, Chapter 952, during construction. Please refer to our Resident Project Representative's notes below. Costs incurred from design and construction utility conflicts understood to result from unmarked, inaccurately marked, or untimely marked utilities include a telecommunications line owned by Lumen, and a hydro power conductor line owned by EBD Hydro LLC.
