## RE: Letter of Support for antkwak Early Learning Center in Hillsboro

On behalf of the Forest Grove School District, I write in strong support of the \$2 million capital funding request for the *antkwak* Early Learning Center, an initiative led by the Northwest Regional Education Service District (NWRESD).
