As a homeowner, I have a direct stake in ensuring the safety and security of our community, and we are facing an increasingly critical situation. While our commitment is unwavering, and we have successfully recruited over 20 volunteer firefighters and acquired essential firefighting apparatus, we lack adequate fire station facilities.

We are a small community spread out over a fairly large area, making fire protection particularly challenging. Our current infrastructure is insufficient to properly house our equipment, provide essential training space, and ensure the rapid deployment necessary to protect our community. As you know, Oregon's rural areas are experiencing increasingly severe fire seasons, placing our homes, livelihoods, and natural resources at heightened risk.
