Dear Committee Members,

This letter is in support of the City of Cornelius' request for Community Project funding to develop Cornelius's first community and recreation center.

We write in support of the City of Cornelius's request for Capital funding for the community's first Recreation and Community Center. The proposed project, located adjacent to City Hall and the Cornelius Library, will re-purpose an existing building – the gym, cafeteria, and associated spaces of the current Cornelius Elementary School. With local bond funding, the school district is nearing completion of a new school on the site, and the City plans to acquire the gym/cafeteria portion of the school building for the new Center.

Last year, the City developed a Concept Plan for the building renovation that reflects substantial community input for what needs the project will address. It will serve critical community needs, including:

- Youth and adult recreation, including basketball, pickle ball, and exercise classes
- Emergency shelter for extreme heat, cold, and other emergencies
- After school activities
- Senior activities
- Arts programming
- Community events

This space will also provide a place for community partners to deliver needed services and programs, enriching lives and building connections.

Cornelius is a culturally rich and diverse community, with more than 50% of the community identifying as Latino. It is also a relatively low income community, and with local government revenue among the lowest in the greater Portland region, local funding of the project is not possible. We simply cannot achieve the project without your support. We urge you to fund the City's request, and thank you for your consideration.
