Co-Chairs and Members of the Committee,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide written testimony in support of SB 5531, and specifically Section 9, which allocates \$20 million to the Oregon Water Resources Department's Water Supply Development Account.

This investment is essential to the continued progress of irrigation infrastructure modernization across Oregon. The funding supports irrigation districts in developing projects that range from initial feasibility studies to full construction.
