My name is Travis Snyder, and I am the owner of Snyder Creek Development, a local firm focused on responsible, community-minded residential construction throughout Southern Oregon. I also serve on the Board of Directors for the Builders Association of Southern Oregon and the Oregon Home Builders Association and am a member of the Chamber of Medford/Jackson County. I am writing to express my strong support for the City of Central Point's capital funding requests currently before your subcommittee.

As a developer, I understand firsthand the challenges of balancing Oregon's housing needs with infrastructure capacity.
