Oregon swim teams are also having to commute longer distances to swim meets when they are from the Corvallis/ Eugene area but now must compete in Beaverton, Portland and Hillsboro. This creates a financial burden for all families involved. Competitive swimmers typically train 5-6 days a week year round and sacrifice much of their free time to their sport. It is what motivates our swimmers to continue to show up to practice day in and day out, weekends and early mornings. Oregon State, compared to other states has much fewer pools to hold competitive events and that affects the quality of swimmers that Oregon produces.
