There is no reason for the 72 hour hold after a background check has been done. Currently background checks are required. Criminals DO NOT follow the law and if a person who was purchasing a firearm intending to use it in an (already) illegal manner, 72 hour waiting period would not ensure any additional safety to the community. Rather if a person wanted to purchase a firearm for personal safety, it would allow for harm to that person within the window.
