I strongly oppose diverting additional future tax revenue towards the construction of a baseball stadium. At a time when the state is already unable to fund critical priorities, such as public education, mass transit, and climate action, we should not be allocating a billion dollars towards a “nice-to-have” project that generates only a few hundred jobs at great cost.

The Legislature previously allocated several hundred million dollars towards this stadium in 2003. That’s already enough to invest for the 500 or so permanent jobs that will be created.

Please prioritize vital public services over a baseball stadium by voting NO on SB 110-A to deny a floor vote for this wasteful bill.
