On May 19, we watched the Joint Ways & Means Subcommittee on Human Services move millions of dollars into developmental disability (DD) services as part of a **spring rebalance**. This was done under a **"Current Service Level Adjustment."**

📜 SB 538 – Tensy's Law

Would ensure children can actually access their Medicaid-funded services.

THIS IS NOT AN ADDITIONAL ASK.
This is a <u>Current Service Level Adjustment</u>.
