




# SUPPORT TENSY'S LAW — SB 538

Let Medicaid dollars *actually* reach our children.

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 **On May 19**, we watched the Joint Ways & Means Subcommittee on Human Services move millions of dollars into developmental disability (DD) services as part of a **spring rebalance**. This was done under a “**Current Service Level Adjustment**.”

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## **SB 538 – Tensy's Law**

Would ensure children can **actually access** their Medicaid-funded services.

→ **THIS IS NOT AN ADDITIONAL ASK.**

→ This is a **Current Service Level Adjustment**.

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## **PLEASE:**

- Do not treat us like just another bill.
  - Prioritize us in caucus.
  - Do not hide behind “Medicaid cuts.” These services are **not part of proposed federal cuts** and will still be funded at **57.7 cents on the dollar**.
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## **Families are begging you to see the truth:**

- Millions are spent in the **NAME** of our children— but not **ON** them.
- Paying parents for caregiving means Medicaid dollars go directly to the child.
