While it may seem to be a minor issue, the passage of this bill is needed because the current zoning doesn't allow for such waste processing. CleanLane involves multiple waste diversion elements including recycling processing, which is already an allowed use. However, other waste diversion technologies such as anaerobic digestion fall into a grey area that this bill clarifies.
