We are writing to you in support of HB485A.

We are small woodland owners who manage our 345 acres of forest land in four parcels located in Lane, Lincoln, and Benton Counties. We are passionate about keeping Oregon's forests sustainable. Our four adult children, Sam, Mike, Joe, and Francesca, are likewise passionate, and our three grandchildren, Allison, Anthony, and Alex, who are just finishing college, are as well. We all work together to help our forests be healthy. We are in our 80s, so the care of these acres will pass to the rest of the family before long. The Natural Resource Estate Tax Exemption is important to us because it will allow our family to go on managing the forest after we are gone without the necessity of early harvesting and/or selling to pay the inheritance taxes.
